Mrs. Yasera Ghosheh is the Minister of Public Sector Development.

She was the Executive Director of the King Abdullah II Center for Excellence (KACE) since its establishment in 2006 to May 2016 .

She was assigned by The Royal Decree as the Coordinator for "The King Abdullah II Award for Excellence in Government Performance and Transparency" since March 2004 to March 2006.

Mrs. Ghosheh worked in the administrative development field in many organizations, where she worked as the technical and legal advisor to the Minister of Public Sector Reform Administration in 2005- 2006.

She worked as the deputy director at the Economic and Development Division in the Royal Hashemite Court in 2002. In addition, she worked as a lecturer in the Business Administration and Finance College at Petra University; she worked also as a legal adviser for nine years, in the beginning of her career life.

Mrs. Ghosheh has two masters degrees from University of Jordan and Birmingham University in Commercial Law, and a bachelor degree in law

from University of Jordan, Mrs. Ghosheh has many certificates in many fields, such as "Negotiation in Leadership" from Dubai School of Government and the Kennedy School of Government, and "Strategic Management for leaders of Non – Governmental Organizations" from Kennedy School of Government – Harvard University.

Mrs. Ghosheh in 2013 was awarded the Order of Al-Hussain for Distinguished contribution (2nd class). Also in the same year she was awarded The Kano Medal for Excellence Catalysts.

Mrs. Ghosheh also attended many courses at the European Foundation for Quality Management (EFQM), such as the "European Excellence Assessors 2003 & 2010", "How to Start the Journey towards Excellence" in 2008 and "Leaders for Excellence" in 2010.

Mrs. Ghosheh has interests in the voluntary work and women's initiatives, as she was member in the board of Chevening graduates, member in the Jordanian Delegation to prepare the regulation of the Arab women organization, member of the legal committee appointed by the prime minister to amend the law of civil procedures, member of the legal committee in the national committee for the Jordanian women and others.
